A student satisfaction survey of student was conducted during academic year 2021-22. All students enrolled in last year (T.Y.) in academic year 2021-22 were informed via what's app group to participate in offline student satisfaction survey, which was conducted after completion of final year examination. The participation of students was voluntary, and the personal data of students/participants were made confidential. The questions were constructed based on college infrastructure, involvement of student support services, effectiveness of communication between students and teachers, adequacy, accessibility and quality of teaching-learning resources, faculty performance student counselling and overall student's satisfaction level. Which was given by NAAC.

A total of 176 students were involved in survey. The conclusion of the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) showed that near about average 60% of respondents reported being excellent, 35% were given very good and 17% of students were given a good rating, 5% have been given a fair remark and around 3% of students gave a poor remark to our college. From the survey, it is shown that near about 95% of the student participants responded (excellent, very good and good) that they were satisfied with academics and facilities provided by the College.






















